

Rules and Regulations

Kerry McCoy's Maryland Wrestling Camp

We are pleased that you will be joining us at the Kerry McCoy's Maryland Wrestling Camp this summer. As a participant in our camp, you are expected to act in a responsible manner and be respectful toward fellow campers, coaches and staff. Campers are required to adhere to the following rules and regulations. Please read this information carefully. Enter your name at the top of this form. Your signature, along with that of a parent or legal guardian, is required and indicates that you agree to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by Kerry McCoy's Maryland Wrestling Camp.

1. Campers are required to attend and be on time to all instructional and activity sessions. Attendance will be taken at the start of each session.
2. All areas off campus are strictly "off limits". This includes Collegetown on Route 1.
3. All other dorms are off limits. There are several other camps being held at the same time. They are not permitted in our dorms and we are not permitted in theirs.
4. Dormitory curfew is 10:00 PM. Final lights out is 11:00 PM. Any camper exiting the dormitory after curfew will be expelled from camp. The camper's parents will be called and must pick up the child the next day. No refund on camp fee will be made for any campers that are dismissed for violation of these rules.
5. Anyone found to have alcohol or drugs in their possession will be immediately dismissed from camp. Upon dismissal, the parent or legal guardian will be notified immediately and must pick up the child immediately. No refund on camp fee will be made for any campers that are dismissed for violation of these rules.
6. Campers will be responsible for all damages to their dorm room.
7. An \$85 check is required at registration as a key deposit. The check will be returned at checkout pending room inspection and return of room keys.
8. If your child is to be picked up after camp by someone other than a parent or guardian, written permission is required and must be provided to the camp in advance.

Our signatures indicate that we have read the rules and regulations and agree to abide by them. Failure to do sign and return this document will prohibit the camper from participating in camp.
